Like you, we want to take good care of the coast we love. In 2016, Saltspring Island Sailing Club became the first Clean Marine BC Eco-Rated Marina in the southern Gulf Islands.

In 2017 Round Saltspring also adopted the Clean Regatta program and earned our first sustainability certificate from Sailors for the Sea. In 2018, the regatta achieved a higher level, earning a Silver Certification.

We are providing racers a drinking water source for refillable bottles in the Event Pavilion to reduce use of single-serve plastic bottles. We have an outstanding recycling program for the race, and we're providing more



information online and less on paper. Please join us in this environmental initiative. Thanks for helping keep our waters blue by going green!
